

Notice of Polling Districts and Polling Places Review

Notice is hereby given that Newcastle City Council ('the council') is conducting a review of the polling districts and polling places that fall within its area, in accordance with Section 18C of the Representation of the People Act 1983.

The (Acting) Returning Officer (ARO) for the Parliamentary constituencies of Newcastle upon Tyne Central and West, East and Wallsend and North will comment on the proposals and those representations will be published on the Council's website and notice boards in accordance with the timetable set out below.

In conducting this review, we will request submissions from the Acting Returning Officer for the part of the Cramlington and Killingworth County Constituency and part of Hexham County Constituency within the Newcastle City Council authority area. These submissions will also be made available for inspection.

The Council would welcome the views of all residents, particularly disabled residents, or any person or body with expertise in access for persons with any type of disability, on the proposals, and ARO's representation, or any other related matters. Representations can be submitted by writing to: Electoral Services Manager, Polling District Review, Electoral Services, Civic Centre, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE1 8QH or by email to pollingstations@newcastle.gov.uk by Monday 11 November 2024.

Persons or bodies making representations should, if possible, give alternative places that may be used as polling places.

All representations must be made by no later than Monday 11 November 2024.
